RESOLUTION 2012-77

CONSIDERATION OF CENTRAL OHIO GAMING VENTURES LLC'S (D/B/A HOLLYWOOD CASINO COLUMBUS) REQUEST FOR CONTROLLED DEMONSTRATION CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION APPROVAL

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission ("Commission") to ensure the integrity of casino gaming by, among other things, licensing and regulating all gaming authorized by Article XV, Section 6(C) of the Ohio Constitution;

WHEREAS, R.C. 3772.03(D) mandates that the Commission prescribe rules to, among other things, prevent practices detrimental to the public and provide for any other thing necessary and proper for successful and efficient regulation of casino gaming under R.C. Chapter 3772;

WHEREAS, Ohio Adm. Code 3772-10-27(A) requires each casino operator licensee to train its licensed employees on the operator's internal control plans and perform at least 1 controlled demonstration of its ability to follow the plans before the Commission will allow the casino facility to open to the public;

WHEREAS, Ohio Adm. Code 3772-10-27(C) requires that the operator's net win from the controlled demonstration go to a charity approved by the Commission;

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2012, Central Ohio Gaming Ventures LLC (d/b/a Hollywood Casino Columbus) submitted its Controlled Demonstration Charitable Organization Request, wherein the operator proposed 5 separate donations of its net win from the controlled demonstration in the denoted percentages:

- (A) Mid-Ohio Food Bank, 3960 Brookham Drive, Grove City, Ohio 43123 (40%);
- (B) Hilltop YMCA, 2879 Valleyview Drive, Columbus, Ohio 43204 (15%);
- (C) Greater Hilltop Area Shalom Zone, 1665 Harrisburg Pike, Columbus, Ohio 43223 (15%);
- (D) The Buckeye Ranch Family Center, 2865 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43204 (15%); and
- (E) The Salvation Army, 2300 West Mound Street, Columbus, Ohio 43204 (15%);

WHEREAS, the Commission considered this matter at its public meeting on September 12, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that Mid-Ohio Food Bank, Hilltop YMCA, Greater Hilltop Area Shalom Zone, the Buckeye Ranch Family Center, and the Salvation Army are **APPROVED** to receive the above-denoted percentages of Hollywood Casino Columbus's net win from its controlled demonstration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution 2012-77 does not restrict or limit the Commission's future exercise of authority and discretion with respect to imposing additional conditions or taking further action upon Hollywood Casino Columbus under R.C. Chapter 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder.
