RESOLUTION 2012-89

**DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO  
DETERMINE WHEN THE IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS IS  
APPROPRIATE AND TO ISSUE NOTICES OF VIOLATION AND  
OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD**

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Casino Control Commission (the "Commission") must complete the functions of licensing, regulating, investigating, and penalizing casino operators, management companies, holding companies, key employees, casino gaming employees, gaming-related vendors, and all other persons participating in or otherwise affecting the integrity of casino gaming in this state; and

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Adm. Code 3772-2-05(A) authorizes the Commission, in its discretion and where permitted by law, to delegate its authority to perform any of its functions to the Executive Director.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Commission that:

1. Prior to the initiation of the administrative hearing process for sanctions, the Commission delegates to the Executive Director the authority to decide when persons, as defined by R.C. 3772.01, may have acted in violation of R.C. Chapter 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder or in some other manner as to affect the integrity of casino gaming in this state; and
2. The Commission also delegates to the Executive Director, upon making such decisions, the authority to authorize Commission staff to issue notices of violation and opportunity to be heard to the relevant parties.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that upon completion of the administrative hearing process, each decision will be brought before the Commission for approval, modification, or disapproval.
