RESOLUTION 2018-08

**DELEGATE AUTHORITY TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO CONSIDER  
WITHDRAWAL REQUESTS**

**WHEREAS**, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”);

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 3772.03(A) and (K) authorize the Commission to ensure the integrity of casino gaming and skill gaming, respectively, through licensing, regulating, investigating, and penalizing all persons under its jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 3772.06 mandates that the Commission appoint an Executive Director who is the agency’s Chief Executive Officer;

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Adm. Code 3772-2-05 allows the Commission, in its discretion and where permitted by law, to delegate authority to perform functions under R.C. Chapter 3772 to the Executive Director; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commission considered this matter at its public meeting on February 21, 2018.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission that the Executive Director is delegated the authority to grant, deny, or otherwise decide upon requests to withdraw applications for licenses issued under R.C. Chapter 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Commission that the Executive Director is delegated the authority to grant, deny, or otherwise decide upon requests to withdraw requests for certifications issued under R.C. Chapter 3772 and the rules adopted thereunder.
