RESOLUTION 2018-23

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY TO APPROVE SKILL-GAMING TECHNOLOGY

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”);

WHEREAS, R.C. 3772.03(K) authorizes the Commission to ensure the integrity of skill gaming through licensing, regulating, investigating, and penalizing all persons under its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, R.C. 3772.06 mandates that the Commission appoint an Executive Director who is the agency’s Chief Executive Officer;

WHEREAS, Ohio Adm. Code 3772-50-02 allows the Commission, in its discretion and where permitted by law, to delegate authority, in a manner consistent with Ohio Adm. Code 3772-2-05, to perform functions under R.C. Chapter 3772 to the Executive Director or other Commission employees; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered this matter at its public meeting on May 16, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that the Executive Director, or designee thereof, is delegated the authority to approve skill-gaming technology under Ohio Adm. Code 3772-50-25.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission maintains the authority to review any determination made pursuant to this delegation as well as the authority to make any such determination if it so chooses or upon request of the Executive Director.
