RESOLUTION 2020-34

**ADMINISTRATIVE RULE – ADOPTION & FINAL FILE**

**WHEREAS**, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”);

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 3772.03 requires or authorizes the Commission to adopt administrative rules pursuant to R.C. Chapter 119 to complete the functions stated in R.C. Chapters 3772 and 3774;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission approved the initial filing of amended Ohio Adm.Code 3772-1-06, “Minimum licensure standards;”

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with R.C. 106.03, the Commission reviewed this rule to determine, among other things, whether it should continue in its current form or should be amended or rescinded;

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with R.C. 121.82, the Commission evaluated the rule and determined it did not have an adverse impact on business;

**WHEREAS**, R.C. 119.03 sets forth the procedure for filing amended rules;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission followed the rule-filing procedure, providing the agency with the authority to adopt the rule;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission considered the matter at its public meeting held on September 16, 2020.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission that the amended rule is **ADOPTED**.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Commission staff is hereby authorized and directed to **FINAL FILE** the amended rule in accordance with R.C. Chapter 119.
