

OHIO CASINO CONTROL COMMISSION

RESOLUTION 2020-35

ADMINISTRATIVE RULE – ADOPTION & FINAL FILE

WHEREAS, Article XV, Section 6(C)(4) of the Ohio Constitution created the Ohio Casino Control Commission (“Commission”);

WHEREAS, R.C. 3772.03 requires or authorizes the Commission to adopt administrative rules pursuant to R.C. Chapter 119 to complete the functions stated in R.C. Chapters 3772 and 3774;

WHEREAS, the Commission approved the initial filing of amended Ohio Adm.Code 3772-50-08, “Type-C skill-based amusement machine location licensure;”

WHEREAS, in accordance with R.C. 106.03, the Commission reviewed this rule to determine, among other things, whether it should be amended and whether it has an adverse impact on business;

WHEREAS, in accordance with R.C. 121.82, the Commission evaluated and filed the rule and accompanying Business Impact Analysis with the Common Sense Initiative Office;

WHEREAS, R.C. 119.03 sets forth the procedure for filing amended rules;

WHEREAS, the Commission followed the rule-filing procedure, providing the agency with the authority to adopt the rule;

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the matter at its public meeting held on September 16, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission that the amended rule is **ADOPTED**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Commission staff is hereby authorized and directed to **FINAL FILE** the amended rule in accordance with R.C. Chapter 119.
