

Voluntary Exclusion Program

As of June 16, 2014 the Ohio Casino Control Commission has accepted 981 applications from 11 states and one Canadian province for the voluntary exclusion program. 75 participants have been removed from the program at the expiration of their exclusion period, and 11 have since asked to be reinstated.
